

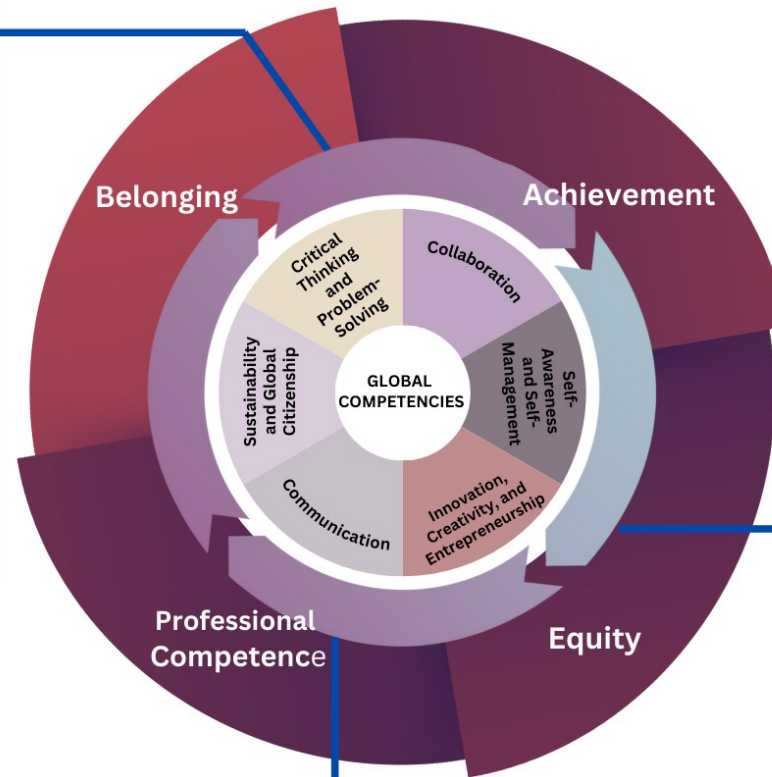
RES Vision

Rothesay Elementary School fosters a nurturing, safe, and welcoming environment grounded in mutual respect, where students are inspired to become life-long learners.

Promote an inclusive and affirming school environment where all members of the community feel welcomed, respected, accepted, and supported. This will be achieved by advancing diversity and anti-racism initiatives, addressing heterosexism and discrimination, creating affirming classroom cultures, and officially becoming a 'Welcoming School' for newcomers. Staff capacity will be strengthened to embed First Nations content across the curriculum. Additionally, a dedicated section of the library will be developed to feature a diverse range of picture books, which will be shared through weekly classroom read-alouds to foster representation and understanding.



Foster a school-wide culture of well-being by integrating positive education practices that promote emotional resilience, mental health, and personal growth—empowering both students and staff to thrive academically and personally. This will be supported through the schoolwide implementation of P.A.W.S. values and the addition of a part-time Behaviour Intervention Mentor (BIM) to lead targeted small-group skill-building sessions.

Build the professional competence of staff and students by implementing a holistic curriculum that integrates the New Brunswick Global Competencies. This approach will foster critical thinking, resilience, and effective problem-solving strategies. To support this goal, all homeroom classes will begin their day with a Direct Targeted Intervention (DTI) block, ensuring daily small-group instruction tailored to individual student needs.
